#### **ABOUT AVENUE Q**

The laugh-out-loud musical tells the timeless story of a recent college grad named Princeton, who moves into a shabby New York apartment all the way out on Avenue Q. He soon discovers that, although the residents seem nice, it's clear that this is not your ordinary neighborhood. Together, Princeton and his newfound friends struggle to find jobs, dates and their ever-elusive purpose in life.

Winner of the Tony "Triple Crown" for Best Musical, Best Score and Best Book, *Avenue Q* is part flesh, part felt and packed with heart.

We encourage performers from all backgrounds, cultural groups, ethnicities, gender identities, physical abilities, and sexual orientations to audition for roles in our shows.

Our audition process is designed to be open and accessible, welcoming a diverse range of performers to participate. This ensures our work reflects the rich diversity of communities across Australia. AG Theatre is committed to creating a safe, inclusive, supportive, and welcoming environment for all talent and crew throughout auditions, rehearsals, pre-production, and performances.

#### **PUPPETS**

Although Avenue Q features puppets, it is M Rated due to its adult themes, strong language, and an onstage portrayal of puppet sex. As a result, the content is not suitable for actors under the age of 18.

The show features both puppet roles and non-puppet roles. For the puppet roles, during the audition actors may have the opportunity to familiarise themselves with the puppetry styles and perform a short segment using a puppet. This will allow actors to gain experience with puppetry and provide the audition panel with an understanding of how comfortable they are with the skill. While previous experience with puppetry is not required, it is recommended that actors do some research beforehand. Workshops and training will be provided throughout the rehearsal process.

Like The Muppets, the characters in Avenue Q are American, with specific accents that reflect this. The production team will be looking for actors who can authentically create the appropriate accents and vocal qualities for each character, without simply imitating prior Avenue Q performances

#### **AUDITION RUNDOWN**

Auditions will take place in Melbourne only. All applicants must reside in Melbourne during the rehearsal and performance periods.

#### **AUDITION SCHEDULE**

#### ROUND 1 - VIDEO SUBMISSION - 14 OCTOBER 2024, 4PM

Applicants are to present at least 32 bars of 2 contemporary songs of contrasting styles that show off their vocal ability and character. It is preferable for at least one song to be from a musical comedy or comic in content.

#### A Note About Self Taping

Please record your self tape in a well lit space with a clean background with your camera/device set in landscape orientation using the rear camera (not screen side camera) and make sure your voice is clear and easily audible (louder than your backing track and without any background noise.

#### ROUND 2 - IN PERSON AUDITIONS - 20 OCTOBER & 23 OCTOBER

On an invitation only basis, applicants will be asked to prepare material from the show including songs and scenes. Materials will be provided to applications upon confirmation of their in person audition booking.

#### CALLBACKS (In Person) 25 OCTOBER & 27 OCTOBER

DANCE CALLBACK (In Person, by invitation) **27 OCTOBER 10:30 AM** If required, applicants will be expected to attend the dance call back.

All audition results are at the sole discretion of the creative team and the company Executive Producer.

During call backs you will be asked to perform song cuts & dialogue from the show. You may be grouped with other auditionees to test chemistry. We are looking for authentic performers who make bold offers, are collaborative, and support each other throughout the audition, rehearsal, and performance phases.

A therapist who recently moved to Avenue Q from Japan. An Asian identifying performer. Gender: female Stage Age: 30 to 45 Vocal range: B3 to F#5

#### **IMPORTANT AUDITION INFORMATION**

- Auditionees may be photographed and recorded as part of their participation in the audition process for casting purposes
- Auditions are at the risk of the auditionee
- Auditionees may be required to stay after their audition should the casting panel wish to see them again that day. Auditionees may be asked to perform additional material at short notice.

#### FAQ

#### What can I expect at rehearsals?

As a part of our commitment to creating a safe and collaborative environment, the production team will support you every step of the way. We understand that some of the subject matter of the show may be sensitive, confronting, and/or challenging - we commit to approaching this content with the utmost respect and care. We aim to create an atmosphere that encourages creativity and mutual respect, whilst maintaining professionalism at all times. We believe that open communication is key to the success of our productions.

#### I'm unavailable for some of the rehearsals. Can I still be involved?

We will consider all applicants and will take into account your unavailability prior to casting. Please indicate any unavailability in your application for the Casting Panel to consider.

#### What is the payment arrangement?

This is an independently produced, non Government funded project. Cast members will be paid a fixed fee for their involvement in the production. Further details will be provided within the contracts which are offered to successful applicants.

#### Is this a profit-share production?

No, we don't expect you to share the risk in producing the show.

#### If I am cast in this show, can I audition for other shows?

If you are considering auditioning for another project during your time on the show, all we ask is that you discuss it with the production team first, so we can make sure that it doesn't conflict with your commitment to this show.

#### When will I find out the outcome of my audition?

SMS and phone call offers are made by the production team within 48 hours after call-backs. We ask that you confirm your acceptance within 24 hours after the offer is made. We will notify all candidates of an audition outcome within 3-4 days after call-backs.

#### What are the promotional requirements?

Cast members may be required to attend additional media calls and photo shoots.
