

#### **AUDITION RUNDOWN**

Applicants will need to outline which role(s) they are applying for.

Auditions will take place in Melbourne only. All applicants must reside in Melbourne during the rehearsal and performance periods.

#### **CASTING**

We are seeking talented singers and comic actors from diverse ethnic backgrounds who can also move well. Our show is fun and silly, designed for a pre-school audience. We are looking for artists who are enthusiastic, flexible, ready to have a good time and eager to engage and entertain young children.

All applicants must be over the age of 18 years and must have existing legal rights to work in Australia.

On an invitation only basis, applicants will be asked to prepare material from the show including songs and scenes. Materials will be provided to applications upon confirmation of their in person audition booking.

CALLBACKS (In Person) 27 AUGUST

All audition results are at the sole discretion of the creative team and the company Executive Producer.

During call backs you will be asked to perform song cuts & dialogue from the show. You may be grouped with other auditionees to test chemistry. We are looking for authentic performers who make bold offers, are collaborative, and support each other throughout the audition, rehearsal, and performance phases.

# **Working With Children Check (WWCC)**

Everyone over the age of 18 who is involved in this production will be required to have a current WWCC (or VIT registration). Please register Theatrical as a nominated organisation and provide us with a copy of your WWCC Statement/VIT card.

Please note: You will be required for all rehearsals. If you have any unavailability during the rehearsal & performance period, please advise us of these dates & times in your audition form. We also ask that you notify us of any other prior commitments which may impact your attendance at rehearsals/performances. A detailed rehearsal schedule will be provided to you at the induction night.

Costume fittings will be scheduled to coincide with rehearsal times where possible. We will negotiate times with you if additional costume fittings are required.

#### CHARACTERS DESCRIPTIONS

## Bar

The oldest of the three little pigs. Popular, athletic, sometimes arrogant. Does not always think things through.

Gender: Male

# Bee

The middle of the three little pigs, and the only girl. Feisty, energetic and passionate about environmental issues. Often annoyed by her brothers.

Gender: Female

# Q

The youngest of the three little pigs. Much more brainy than brawny; an avid reader and studier, but not very athletic. Loves his family and wants them to be together. Clever and resourceful.

Clever and resourcerd

Gender: Male

# **Mother Pig**

The Pigs' mother. Loves her children very much, but also wants them to be responsible in the real world.

Gender: Female

# **Big Bad Wolf**

A cocky, ravenous, Wolf with a taste for pig. Believes himself to be misunderstood.

Gender: Male

**Twit/Twoo** (played by Bar and Bee) Two owls who sing backup for the Big Bad Wolf.

Gender: Any

Merchant (played by Mother Pig)
The seller of straw, sticks and bricks

## IMPORTANT AUDITION INFORMATION

- Auditionees may be photographed and recorded as part of their participation in the audition process for casting purposes
- · Auditions are at the risk of the auditionee
- Auditionees may be required to stay after their audition should the casting panel wish to see them again that day. Auditionees may be asked to perform additional material at short notice.

## What can I expect at rehearsals?

As a part of our commitment to creating a safe and collaborative environment, the production team will support you every step of the way. We understand that some of the subject matter of the show may be sensitive, confronting, and/or challenging - we commit to approaching this content with the utmost respect and care. We aim to create an atmosphere that encourages creativity and mutual respect, whilst maintaining professionalism at all times. We believe that open communication is key to the success of our productions.

## I'm unavailable for some of the rehearsals. Can I still be involved?

We will consider all applicants and will take into account your unavailability prior to casting. Please indicate any unavailability in your application for the Casting Panel to consider.

## Is there a show fee?

No, we won't ask you to pay a show fee.

# What is the payment arrangement?

This is an independently produced, non Government funded project. Cast members will be paid a fixed fee for their involvement in the production. Further details will be provided within the contracts which are offered to successful applicants.

# Is this a profit-share production?

No, we don't expect you to share the risk in producing the show.

# If I am cast in this show, can I audition for other shows?

If you are considering auditioning for another project during your time on the show, all we ask is that you discuss it with the production team first, so we can make sure that it doesn't conflict with your commitment to this show.

# When will I find out the outcome of my audition?

SMS and phone call offers are made by the production team within 48 hours after call-backs. We ask that you confirm your acceptance within 24 hours after the offer is made. We will notify all candidates of an audition outcome within 3-4 days after call-backs.

# What are the promotional requirements?

Cast members may be required to attend additional media calls and photo shoots.
